DAILY LECTURES WILL BE LED BY ACADEMICS OF CIVIS PARTNER UNIVERSITIES AND GUESTS FROM THE ART SCENE WILL PARTICIPATE IN THE TWO ROUND TABLES OFFERED. DEVELOPING LANGUAGE SKILLS WILL ALSO BE A CENTRAL POINT, AS LANGUAGE LEARNING ALLOWS, NOT ONLY FOR EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION, BUT TO PROMOTE UNDERSTANDING AND RESPECT FOR CULTURAL DIFFERENCES.

STUDENTS FROM ALL BACKGROUNDS AND GEOGRAPHIES ARE WELCOME TO PARTICIPATE AND CONTRIBUTE TO THE REFLECTION, ALTHOUGH PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO STUDENTS FROM CIVIS MEMBER UNIVERSITIES, WHO WILL BENEFIT FROM A MOBILITY SCHOLARSHIP. APPLICANTS SHOULD SEND A SHORT CV AS WELL AS A MOTIVATION LETTER.
